

Review Quiz #2 - Substitutions correct answer in bold

1. A1 commits a foul against B1 in the act of shooting inside the 3-point arc. A6, B6, B7 are all at the table to report into the game. When are these players allowed in the game?
- Before the first shot, after the first shot, and/or after the second shot if the second shot is made.
 - Before the first shot and/or after the second shot if the second shot is made.**
 - Before the first shot, after the first shot, and/or after the second shot.
 - Only after the second shot and only if it is made.

32 Members responded, percentage of answers chosen. a.0% **b.93.8%** c.3.1% d.3.1%
(Rule 3-6.2b) *During multiple free throws for personal fouls, a substitute may enter the game only before the first attempt in the sequence unless otherwise authorized by the rules or after the final attempt has been successfully converted.*

2. A1 commits a foul against B1 in the act of shooting outside the 3-point arc. A6, B6, B7 are all at the table to report into the game. When are these players allowed in the game?
- Before the first shot, after the first shot, after the second shot, and/or after the third shot.
 - Before the first shot and/or after the second shot.
 - Before the first shot, and/or after the third shot if the third shot is made.**
 - Only after the third shot and only if it is made.

32 Members responded, percentage of answers chosen. a.0% b.0% **c.100%** d.0%
(Rule 3-6.2b) *During multiple free throws for personal fouls, a substitute may enter the game only before the first attempt in the sequence unless otherwise authorized by the rules or after the final attempt has been successfully converted.*

3. A6 legally substitutes for A1 before a throw-in. After the official hands the ball to B1 for a throw-in but before the ball is legally touched, B2 commits an offensive foul. A1 reports back to the table to sub in. Which is correct?
- A1 is not allowed to come back into the game because no time has come off of the clock.
 - A1 is allowed to come back into the game, but only if the head coach of Team A calls a timeout.
 - A1 is allowed to come back into the game, but is only allowed to replace A6.
 - A1 is allowed to come back into the game, and may replace any team A member on the floor.**

32 Members responded, percentage of answers chosen. a.12.5% b.3.1% c.0% **d.84.4%**

(Rule 3-6.j.1) A replaced player may re-enter the game at the next opportunity to substitute when the opposing team has committed a foul or a violation before the game clock has properly started.

4. A6 legally substitutes for A1 and B6 legally substitutes for B3 before a throw-in. After the official hands the ball to B1 for a throw-in but before the ball is legally touched, B2 commits an offensive foul. A1 and B3 report back to the table to sub in. Which is correct?
- A1 and B3 are not allowed to come back into the game because no time has come off of the clock.
 - A1 and B3 are allowed to come back into the game, but only if either head coach calls timeout.
 - Only A1 is allowed to come back into the game because Team B committed a foul, causing a change of possession.**
 - A1 is allowed to come back into the game because Team B committed a foul, causing a change of possession. Because a sub was allowed for Team A, B3 is allowed to report into the game.

32 Members responded percentage of answers chosen. a.12.5% b.9.4% c.53.1% d.25%

(Rule 3-6.j.1) *A replaced player may re-enter the game at the next opportunity to substitute when the opposing team has committed a foul or a violation before the game clock has properly started. (ONLY THE OFFENDED TEAM MAY SUB)*

5. A1 is called for traveling violation. Head Coach of team A curses at the official in disagreement with the call. The official assesses a technical foul to the head coach. Before the technical free throws are shot, Head coach of Team B wishes to substitute B6 for B1, wants B6 to shoot the free throws, and then sub B1 back in for B6. Which is correct?
- The official informs Head Coach B that B6 may enter and shoot the free throws, and B6 may leave the floor after that, but B1 cannot come back onto the floor until the clock has legally started.**
 - The official informs Head Coach B that B6 may enter and shoot the free throws, but B6 cannot leave the floor after that, and B1 cannot come back onto the floor until the clock has legally started.
 - The official informs Head Coach B that B6 may not enter and shoot the free throws, someone already on the floor must shoot the free throws, and then B6 may enter the game.
 - The official informs Head Coach B that he/she is correct and allows what the coach is requesting.

32 Members responded, percentage of answers chosen. a.25% b.40.6% c.0% d.34.4%

(Rule 3-6.j) A player who has been withdrawn or replaced by a substitute may re-enter the game at the next opportunity to substitute, provided that the game clock has been properly started after the withdrawal or replacement.
